As many of you have heard by now, Lemon Leaf Restaurant owner Maria Elena Grado has filed a lawsuit against Antelope Valley Country Club for breach of contract. The original contract between AV Country Club and Lemon Leaf is July 23, 2020 to July 23, 2023. Our legal team has advised us not to discuss the matter at this time. The board has appointed former board member Greg Cich to a special committee for Legal Affairs. Mr. Cich will be coordinating our legal team.

The club is changing the Point of Sale system from Club Essentials to Teesnap on June 1, 2023. This change encompasses the member webpage, member login, member charge account and electronic tee sheet for making tee times. This new system is far superior for accurate accounting information which will help guide us in future financial decisions to make the club more profitable. The front office will be setting up training sessions for accessing the new system. Please be patient with all the staff throughout the club as they are also learning this new system.

Lastly, our liquor license is currently being changed from that of a PRIVATE CLUB to being able to serve the public. We feel this change will bring in much needed revenue from all avenues. We anticipate the transformation to be in place within the next few weeks.

- -continue troubleshooting and adjusting irrigation




