Great news regarding our club carts. Yamatrack, a GPS system is scheduled to begin first week of September. This technology will enable geofencing preventing carts from approaching too close to the greens and other "blackout" areas on the course. It will provide yardage for pin placement, so there's no excuse for not hitting your ball the right distance! The pro shop will be able to view gaps in play. You will be able to view a breakfast and lunch menu as you round the eighth hole to place an order. And, you can advertise your business! Please see Mark for the details.

Mark has been preparing amazing Friday night dinners with something for everyone. He changes the menu each week giving you options. If you like pork chops and have never tried Mark's, you're missing out. And another thing, his portions will fill you up and then some. You definitely won't walk away hungry. 


